Investment Certificate for OBV in Binh Dinh

### Outward Bound Vietnam and Ecotourism projects

October 2014 – Pegasus received the Investment Certificate for its flagship project – Outward Bound Vietnam (OBV) and Eco-tourism in Vinh Phuc Province to be developed over 3 phases on 24.89ha land site at Dong Cau Lake, Binh Xuyen District, Vinh Phuc Province.

In July 2015, Pegasus received the Investment Certificate for Outward Bound Vietnam and Eco-tourism in Quy Nhon City, Binh Dinh Province.

These developments mark an important milestone for KinderWorld and its plan to eventually operate 5 Outward Bound campuses in Vietnam.

### Pegasus International University in Nha Trang City, Khanh Hoa Province

To meet growing demands of high quality human resources in hospitality and tourism sector in Khanh Hoa province, a Pegasus International University project will be developed on a 6ha site in My Gia New Urban Area, Nha Trang City. The project will comprise of Pegasus International University, College Housing and Training Hotel. Within its educational scope, Pegasus International University will provide courses in Hospitality, Business Management, Information and Communication Technology as well as English Language Training. Pegasus already obtained the Location agreement for the project in July 2014.

## **Grand Opening of Pegasus Mixed Education Development and International Conference on Sustainable Human Capital Development for Hospitality and Tourism, Vietnam in the context of ASEAN**

The Grand Opening of Phase One of Pegasus Mixed Education Development and an International Conference on Sustainable Human Capital Development for Hospitality and Tourism, Vietnam in the context of ASEAN was held on 22 May 2015 in Danang.

The event marks the official opening of Pegasus International College and Singapore International School in Danang. Pegasus International College is the first international college in Danang offering high quality courses in Hospitality, Tourism, Culinary Arts and Business and Commerce to meet the ever increasing demand for skilled labour in the hospitality industry.

The College was granted the College Operating License by MOET on 16 June 2015, making it the first foreign investment in higher education to be established in central Vietnam. The College is now looking forward to welcoming students' enrolment from the middle of August 2015.

The International Conference on Sustainable Human Capital Development for Hospitality and Tourism, Vietnam in the context of ASEAN provided an insight on the role of education in human resource development, sustainability and growth within the Hospitality and Tourism industry in Vietnam.
