■ Grand Opening Ceremony of Singapore International School @ Le Chan, Hai Phong

Singapore International School (SIS) in Le Chan, Hai Phong grand opening ceremony was held on 11 May 2025. Ceremony participants included Major General Vu Thanh Chuong – Member of Standing Committee of Hai Phong’s Municipal Party Committee, Director of Hai Phong Police Department and other leaders from local Departments and Agencies. Leading up to the 70th Anniversary of Hai Phong’s Liberation and the Hai Phong’s Red Flamboyant Festival 2025, SIS @ Le Chan was selected as a notable project which has contributed to the city’s overall development.

■ Collaboration with Singapore Management University (SMU)

On 28 June, KIG and Novaland Group signed an MOU to establish KinderWorld International Kindergarten (KIK) and SIS in 4 potential land plots in Aqua City urban area, Dong Nai, Vietnam. The first school campus, slated for a 2026 opening, will feature premier modern facilities and include science labs, a STEM room, football fields, a swimming pool and athletic centre, all designed to foster academic achievement and extracurricular development.

■ Singapore International School @ Binh Duong New City Phase 3

Construction for Phase 3 of SIS @ Binh Duong New City is moving towards completion and is expected to open in the school year 2025 - 2026. The new phase brings in 21 additional classrooms, expanding the school's total capacity to 800 students. Students will also enhance their learning and co-curricular engagements through new innovative science laboratories, a high-tech STEM room as well as art and music rooms.

■ Singapore International School @ SwanBay, Dong Nai

Phase 1 of the SIS @ SwanBay, Dong Nai is in its final stage and set to open in August 2025. Spanning across 1.4 hectares with a capacity of more than 700 students, the first phase will comprise 29 classrooms, a full-sized football field, basketball court, swimming pool, a multi-purpose sports hall and other premium amenities to support both academic and athletic excellence.

■ **SISH International High School @ Paya Lebar Green, Singapore**

SISH International High School at Paya Lebar Green, Singapore is scheduled to open in September 2025, the school offers the internationally recognised Cambridge curriculum for Year 7 to Year 12 students. This is the first campus within KIG’s network of schools that is equipped with an advanced artificial intelligence (AI) lab and an enhanced STEM curriculum, co-developed with UBTECH - a global leading AI and humanoid robotics company.



■ **MOU Signing between SISH Institute and Le Shan Normal University, Sichuan, China**

During a recent visit to Sichuan, China, SISH Institute signed an MOU with Le Shan Normal University to strengthen academic collaboration. The agreement includes the launch of a Vatel MBA Chinese programme for Le Shan graduates and opens the articulation pathway for fourth-year students to obtain Vatel’s Bachelor Degree in Singapore. Both institutions will also implement a summer teachers exchange programme to promote cross-cultural learning and professional development.



■ **Hong Kong**

In March, KIG delegates made a business trip to Hong Kong to further explore education investment opportunities. During the trip, our management team visited potential sites, international schools and continued discussions with our banking and financial partners. These visits provided valuable insights into potential campus locations and business models that could be established in Hong Kong.

■ **New Programme: Advanced Diploma in Cooking Techniques**

PIC has been approved by the Ministry of Education and Training (MoET) to offer Advanced Diploma in Cooking Techniques (Vietnamese programme) and recently welcomed the first intake at PIC Da Nang campus. Aligned with international standards, the programme equips students with strong foundations in culinary and patisserie technical skills and instills professional work ethics, preparing students for careers in top-tier restaurants and hotels in Vietnam and abroad.



■ **Effective Presentation Skills Training at Melia Hanoi Hotel**

The “Effective Presentation Skills” course was conducted for 20 managerial personnel at the 5-star Melia Hanoi Hotel. The course enabled participants to improve their public speaking and persuasive communication skills through hands-on practice, constructive feedback and interactive skills refinement.



■ **Hotel Management Training for SAN STUDIOS' Accommodation Chain**

SAN STUDIOS' chain of homestays and hotels has selected PIC as its official training provider for a tailored 25-session VTOS-Standard Hotel Management course to strengthen its management skills. In June, participants began applied learning with on-site evaluations at Lucien Hanoi Lakeside Hotel, a flagship SAN STUDIOS property. They conducted operational analysis, produced detailed reports and presented recommendations to enhance service quality across their businesses.
