

KINDERWORLD INTERNATIONAL GROUP (KIG)

■ Mainland China Expansion

During the first half of 2026, KIG expanded its China business development efforts through several new strategic partnerships which included the signing of an international education cooperation agreement with Zhonglou District Government in Changzhou, a 10-year framework agreement with Tumyu Group in Wuhan, and the development of new international education initiatives in Nanning and Hengqin. These partnerships strengthens KIG's position as a leading regional education enterprise connecting China, ASEAN and Singapore.



■ Hong Kong – Wang On Partnership

KIG continued its Hong Kong market entry, signing a Collaborative Framework Agreement with Wang On Properties Limited to jointly develop an international school within Wang On's Maya development in Kowloon Bay. The project will be launched in phases: a high-school campus by August 2027 scaling onwards to a Years 1-12 institution with boarding by 2030. The partnership combines Wang On's property arm with KinderWorld's Singapore education curriculum model and regional operating expertise to reinforce its cross-border education network linking China, Hong Kong, ASEAN and Singapore.

■ SISH Visit To Myanmar

SISH conducted a 10-day visit to Myanmar, covering Yangon, Mandalay, Bago and Shan State to gain deeper insights into student recruitment opportunities. The team also engaged in dialogues with school directors, education agents and prospective students to better understand market needs and strengthen relationships. These findings will support the development of targeted recruitment initiatives, enhance engagement strategies and foster stronger regional partnerships within the Myanmar market.

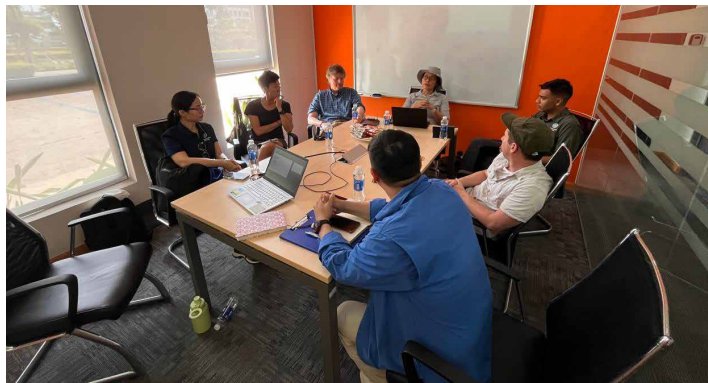

■ Association for Experiential Education Accreditation Renewal

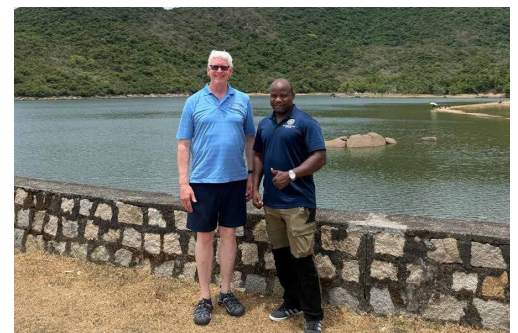
